T-Ball League Rules

League Objective

The T-ball league is an instructional league. Coaches are expected to teach players the fundamentals of baseball. Coaches are expected to be role models and keep the focus of the game on the kids. A positive learning experience at this age will motivate players to do their best and continue to play baseball.

League Rules

Play:

- Players should play all positions during the season.
- All players will bat each inning. The inning is over once all players have batted.
- No outs or score will be kept.
- All calls will be made by the coaches.

Fielding:

- A maximum number of 11 players on the field.
- Coaches will be allowed on the field to instruct.
- No infield fly rule.
- Runners can advance to next base until ball in pitcher's possession.

Hitting:

- Batters will rotate in order for the entire game.
- No strike out or walks. When coach is pitching, 4 good pitches will be thrown, if the batter does not hit, then the tee will be brought out to hit from.
- Base runners may not steal or lead off.
- All batters and runners must wear helmets.
- No bunting is allowed.
- Only one base for each hit and base runners will advance only one base at a time.
- Once a player has ran around all bases, he/she will return to the dugout.
